Sir Doggy's dinner set

- Step 1: Layout the CRYSTALLIZED™ Flat Backs No Hotfix elements as shown in the pattern in the illustration in the first picture. Put a small drop of glue on to the bowl and set the CRYSTALLIZED™ Flat Backs No Hotfix with tweezers as shown.
- Step 2: Set the entire first row as in pattern and mark the ending and beginning point with the help of a pencil as shown in the illustration. Draw the lines down the bowl.
- Step 3: Repeat steps 1 and 2 to complete the entire first row around the dish.
- Step 4: Repeat steps 1 and 2 for applying the rows 2 – 18 in the pattern on the bowl.
- Step 5: Layout a second pattern as shown in the illustration. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to apply this pattern of rows 2 – 5 on the sides of the wooden board as shown in the illustration.
- Step 6: Repeat step 5 to cover this entire side of the board with the same pattern of crystals as shown in the illustration.
- Step 7: Repeat the steps 5 and 6 to apply the crystals, on all the other sides of the wooden board as shown in the illustration. There should be equal distance between all of them.
- Step 8: Draw an oval and print it out. It should fit the letter that you later choose to put inside this oval. Our letter will be "G" and the size of the oval would be 4.6x3.4 cm.
- Step 9: Put a transparent paper above the oval and set the crystals with the tweezers inside the borders of the oval as shown in the illustration. All of them are jet in color except one black diamond. Now put a sticky foil with the sticky side down onto the oval and press it onto the crystals.
- Step 10: Pull the sticky foil up
- Step 11: As mentioned in step 8, we will print out the letter "G". Make sure your letter is thick enough to be filled with SS 12 crystals. Repeat step 9 to fill in letter with crystal and with the text being placed in the middle of the oval as seen in the illustration.
- Step 12: Place the logo on the wooden board, mark lines with a pencil where the logo will be placed.
- Step 13: Put a small amount of glue on the back of each crystal with a tooth pick.
- Step 14: Place the logo where you earlier marked with the pencil and let the glue dry.
- Step 15: Remove the foil from the crystals and erase the pencil marks.
